- Tufts has contributed \$1,375,000 over 5 years (2013 2018) to Somerville
- Tufts waives the application fee for Somerville High School students
- Tufts Dean of Admission personally reads and evaluates their applications
- Tufts pays for *Let's Get Ready* (a SAT program at SHS)
- Tufts offers the *Kids to College* program to Somerville students
